At Castle Day Nursery we observe a no nut policy therefore please do not send your child with any items that may contain nuts i.e. nutty spread such as peanut butter/ Nutella or any loose nuts.

Please can we ask not to put sweets in your child lunch boxes **Ensure that lunchbox contains ice pack throughout the year.**

Nappies/Clothes Please ensure your child has nappy sacks, wipes and nappies if required and label as many items of clothes as possible. All children also require a spare set of clothes if they are in nappies or not.

Please note that there has been many changes to invoices due to children being funded, therefore please check that sessions on invoice match your child attendance.
